Course: A scenic 5K certified course (AL16002JD) that starts at Fort Gaines and winds through scenic Dauphin Island neighborhoods.

Virtual Option: If you can't make it to the race site Saturday morning, you now have the option to participate virtually. When you sign up for the BOMB, select "Virtual" as your style. You will get a race shirt and race bib - your mission will be to run/walk a 5K within one week and report your results to us.

Registration: Pre-register by mail (entries should be postmarked by February 13), in person at McCoy Outdoor, Run-N-Tri, or Fleet Feet in Mobile or Running Wild in Fairhope until noon on February 18, or online on Events.com at until 4 AM February 19. Early packet pick-up and registration will be available at the PCP office (358 Morgan Ave) on Friday, February 19, from noon until 5:30 PM. Race day registration on Dauphin Island from 7:15 to 8:15 AM.

Entry fees: **Pre-registered:** \$20 Non-PCP members (with shirt) \$18 PCP members **Day of Race:** \$25 Everyone (with shirt)

Pre-registered: \$17 Non-PCP members (NO SHIRT) \$15 PCP members **Day of Race:** \$20 Everyone (NO SHIRT)

***PCP Members 12 and under may participate for free – (\$7 with shirt) – if they pre-register

Awards: Top 3 Male & Female Overall, top Male and Female Masters, Grandmasters, Senior Grandmasters, and race walkers. Top 3 male and female finishers in 5-year age groups.

Shirts: Participants registered by February 13 are guaranteed a premium BOMB 5K shirt. Otherwise, shirts are available while supplies last.

Post race: Food, beverages, and awards will be provided. **We will be following the CDC recommended COVID-19 guidelines.**
